National Accreditation Standards Recommendations

- Cpl. Burns reviewed the <u>minimum</u> items that should be addressed to avoid civil liability:
 - 1. Evidence needs to be secured in a separate room separate & away from where prisoners are processed and the room needs to be utilized only for maintaining the integrity of the chain of custody.
 - 2. There should be a separate **Toilet Facility for Detainees** without a lock on the door.
 - 3. There should be a **Detainee Holding Area** that is not in close proximity to the desks where officers doing a warrant are in reaching, spitting and kicking distance.
 - 4. There needs to be a **Second Detainee Bench** so when there are multiple detainees, they can be separated.
 - <u>Juveniles</u> must be sight and sound separate from adult prisoners.
 - <u>Males and females</u> must be at lease sight separate from one another.




