The Adopt-A-Canal/Road-End Program sponsored by South Bethany's Community Enhancement Committee (CEC) is growing – richly nourished by the generosity of our South Bethany volunteers! The Adopt Program started in 2011 with a single adoption that grew to 6 adoptions, then to 13 in 2012 and now this spring, we are proud to announce that a total of 32 canal/road ends have been adopted. New adoption sites are found on Henlopen Drive (Carol & Todd Stevenson), W. 10th Street (Pat & Frank Weisgerber) and four new ones along Route 1 at New Castle (Kathy Jankowski and many contributors), Layton (Pat Voveris), Anchorage (Garnet Timbario) and the area in front of the Anchorage Forebay (Earth Day). We continue to appreciate the property owners who are volunteering their time, energy and funds to improve the landscaping at these town-owned canal/road ends.
