The committee has not been able to meet since the Quarantine of Delaware began. We continue to plan activities as we are able via phone. Now that we are in the “phased return to normal,” we will be meeting as soon as we can arrange.

Our planned Town Party on July 5th will not be held due to the difficulty of managing social distancing and so many other issues. We want to keep these activities safe for our town staff, volunteers, and guests. We reduced the number of bonfires to just one in August.

At this writing, social activities will be limited to a Movie on the Beach on Wednesday July 15th with a rain date of July 16th. A Town Bonfire will be tentatively held on August 8th with the assistance of the Lifeguards. Our plans to hand out food and other items will not happen due to Covid restrictions.
