

Town Council Report
Communications and Public Relations Committee Report
November 13, 2020

The committee met electronically on November 3, 2020. All members were present. The committee decided not to plan any public activities for the remainder of the fiscal year due to the uncertainty of the pandemic and quarantine restrictions. The committee will work to repair the Town bulletin boards until such a time as they can be replaced with better ones that will be weather tight. The Committee will plan to provide a Holiday Luncheon for the entire Town Staff. This modest catered event will be set up for employees to attend as they are able and for the safety of all will not involve any contact on the part of the committee members and staff.

The Committee discussed activities that may be able to occur in 2021-22. We will plan and budget for a full line up of activities for the upcoming fiscal year. The Committee voted to support the 50th Anniversary Celebration of the Beach Patrol. This event will be planned by the Lifeguards and will honor past and present Beach Patrol Members. The Beach Patrol Captain plans to open the event up for all residents of the town. Initial plans call for a beach event in mid-June.

Other activities that will be included in the proposed 2022 budget are:

- A Town Independence Day Parade Float for July 4, 2021.
- A Beach Movie held on July 21, 2021 with a rain date of July 22, 2021
- A Bonfire and End of Summer Party to be held August 28, 2021
- A Halloween Pot Luck Supper on October 23, 2021
- A Caroling Party on December 5, 2021 with several Trolleys
- A St. Patrick's Potluck Supper on March 12, 2022

Of course, all activities and programs are subject to change due to Covid related issues.
