

Mayor Report  
April 7, 2020

1. Attended teleconferences with the Governor regarding COVID 19 and the public health crisis. These meetings continue to be very informative and provided information for municipalities to make informed thoughtful decisions. Information that was received was passed along to Town Council members.
2. Attended the ACT meeting on April 1st. ACT reviewed their Charter and made minor changes to bring clarity to the document. Also had a report from the ACT lobbyist on the Delaware State Legislative session. I will provide an update on this topic via the minutes that should be issued in early May.
3. Worked with the Treasurer, Finance Director and Town Manager on Town Finance analyses and updates to the FY2022 proposed budget.
4. Along with Maureen Hartman met with Mike Dunmyer of US Wind . The purpose of the meeting was to have an introduction to US Wind and their proposed offshore wind farm off of the coast of Ocean City, MD.
5. Town Council and committees continue to meet via electronic methods as per the guidelines of the State. Our goal is to continue business as usual to the best of our ability.
6. The Town Council to began meeting in person with the March 25<sup>th</sup> Workshop meeting. The public continues to attend virtual. Town Committees can now meet in person or virtual. The goal is to move all meetings in person starting in May.
