CEC TC MEETING REPORT

FEBRUARY 11, 2022

<u>CEC MEETING</u> – The CEC last met on Friday, November 19, 2021. No future meetings are scheduled at this time.

UPDATES ON TOPICS DISCUSSED

1) The status and condition of the oyster beds and the grasses installed in the canal waterways.

Sue has spoken with the Town Manager, the previous WQC Chair, and Councilman Abbott regarding these issues. The CEC is waiting for feedback from the WQC.

2) Improvement of the ROW area at the corner of Evergreen and Route 1

The CEC appreciates the follow-up to this request by the Public Works and the Code Enforcement Officer. This area will be landscaped in the spring 2022.

3) Little Free Libraries

The CEC's request to the Council at the December meeting for a budget amendment to use remaining FY22 funds to replace the LFLs in the current FY budget time period was approved. In addition, the SBPOA has offered to fund the LFL replacements and also to fund the landscaping of a canal end. The CEC is following up on both endeavors. In addition, property owner Frank Weisgerber has agreed to build a new LFL for the Town Hall location.
