Police Officer Recruit Matthew Boyd has successfully completed his first month of training at the Dover Police Academy.

I completed a three-day advanced police instructor course which will enhance or in house department training. This course tuition and travel costs was funded with a law enforcement grant.

The department is currently reviewing applications for one vacant police officer position.

Two officers were sick and out of service for a week each after testing positive for COVID. Both officers have fully recovered and are back to full duty.
