

Town Council Discussion: Back-up Plan for Spring Algae Removal

December 9, 2022



## Five (5) Options Evaluated

Today we present combined A & D as the plan for Spring '23

- A. Continue to rely upon DNREC
- B. Buy Equipment and hire staff
- C. Buy Equipment and contract staff
- D. Contract for Algae removal services (as back-up)
- E. Option A staying with DNREC, but with ability to use their equipment if available (DNREC researching this as a feasible option or not)

## Option D Back-up Plan - Summary

- 1. Contract with Solitude @ weekly rate of \$19,996, comprised of:
  - i. Mobilization cost of \$4,996;
  - ii. Day rate for operator and equipment for 8 hours of \$3,000;
  - iii. Minimum deployment is 5 days; and,
  - iv. 50% fully refundable deposit due at contract execution
- 2. We have 2 separate weeks preliminarily set up for: April 17 21 and May 15 19, 2023
- Likely need some additional budget for temporary DPW staff of 1 to 2 personnel for these two weeks plus training period to perform the loading and transfer to disposal site; approach and \$ TBD
- 4. We will have some nominal insurance coverage costs as well

## Next Steps Upon Approval

- 1. Finalize contract with Solitude as our back-up plan, including 50% fully refundable deposit at time of execution
- 2. Reconfirm agreement with DNREC to perform Algae Harvesting
- 3. Secure necessary final written approvals from DNREC for disposal by Town of South Bethany of Algae spoils at the Fresh Pond Trailhead
- 4. Finalize plan, secure and train temporary resource(s) by March 24, 2023 to perform the loading and transfer of Algae to dumping site
- 5. Finalize logistics and approvals for launching equipment and off-loading / loading the Algae spoils by March 24, 2023
- 6. Finalize any additional insurance or other coverage matters for the operations and personnel no later than date of training
