## Mayor Report June 5, 2023

- 1. Attended the June ACT meeting on June 1st. A presentation was provided by the CIB regarding a new study they hope to initiate regarding the back bay. Other items discussed were:
  - The bill reducing the number of employees to 25 for the ability to organize as a union.
  - HB 127 was discussed regarding Fire Company funding. The Towns were in support of this bill. I sent an email to the bill sponsor and found it has been delayed until January 2024 due to push back from Kent and Sussex county officials.
- 2. Attended a meeting with Bethany Beach, Sea Colony, Fenwick Island and BBFD EMS regarding the renewal of the BBFD EMS agreement. The Agreement is set to renew in January 2024.
- 3. Attended the Weekly Meetings on 2023 DE beach re-nourishment. Currently South Bethany is scheduled for a start the week of June 5th for beach re-nourishment. It will take approximately 19 days. This is all subject to change based on weather and any equipment issues.
- 4. Met with constituents on a variety of issues.
