New Resiliency Committee Formed

The Town Council has formed a new committee to assist in evaluating risks to infrastructure and public and private property from threats including coastal erosion, storms and flooding events, and sea level rise, and to aid in developing and implementing plans and projects to mitigate those risks. All meetings of the Resiliency Committee will be open to the public and will follow posted agendas.

Town Awarded Hazard Mitigation Grant

The Town was recently awarded a hazard mitigation grant from FEMA to fund an engineering study that will evaluate possible measures to address flooding on York Road and adjoining streets. A request for proposals is currently being drafted with the hope that a consultant will be hired and the study will commence in early 2024.

Save the Date for Second Annual Tree Lighting

The Community Relations Committee will be hosting South Bethany's second Annual Tree Lighting on December 2nd at 5 p.m. Join us in the fitness area outside Town Hall for cookies and cocoa, live music, and good cheer.
