The police department has updated their social media programs. We have a new Facebook account named "The South Bethany Police". We have also started a Neighbors Public Safety Service with Ring doorbell cameras which will allow us to push notifications throughout the Town for residence that utilize the Ring camera social media page.

We are anticipating our presence on social media will help build a trustworthy relationship and a sense of community by engaging with residents, provide a platform for people to ask questions and share concerns, and help us rapidly share information to protect the community.

The police department has begun the process of attaining law enforcement accreditation. We are reviewing all policies and procedures to ensure they are in line with State and Federal mandates and best practices and providing proofs the department is practicing the policies.

All officers have exceeded the yearly mandatory minimum training and certifications required by POST (Police Officer Standards & Training).
