Town Council to Hold Special Workshop

The Town Council will hold a special workshop on **April 17th at 10 a.m.** to discuss possible changes to the maximum floor-to-area ratio (FAR) restriction found in Chapter 145-35.G of the Town Code. A Councilman has proposed an increase in the current maximum ratio of 71% of total lot area. Council will debate whether any change to the code is warranted.
