



Chief of Police Monthly Report for June 2024

New video surveillance / security cameras and a key card door locking system for the police department have been installed. The project was completed on June 25, 2024. The cost of this project was approximately \$25,000, which was fully funded by a Homeland Security grant.

As our surrounding community continues to grow in popularity, our police officers are more in demand than ever. I have reviewed the police activity for 2022 to current. (January 1 – June 30)

2022: 417 tickets / arrests, 78 calls for police service, 91 parking tickets.

2023: 393 tickets / arrest, 163 calls for police service, 53 parking tickets.

2024: 797 tickets / arrests, 325 calls for police service, 55 parking tickets.
