## **Sussex County Property Reassessment Update**

Sussex County recently announced that homeowners may begin receiving tentative property assessments as early as mid-November. Officials stressed that property owners should look for these important documents, as they will be used, once finalized, as part of the equation in determining each parcel's annual tax bill. Owners should review the documents, and notify the County's vendor, Tyler Technologies, if they disagree with their parcel's valuation. Our staff is in the process of completing a Town-wide assessment of stormwater drains and addressing deferred maintenance. You can help ease the maintenance burden and reduce street flooding by keeping the area around any drain on your property free and clear of rocks, earth, or other landscaping material that may impede flow into the drains. Please contact Town Hall if you observe any work by utility companies that covers or blocks a storm drain.
