## TOWN COUNCIL REPORT RESILIENCY COMMITTEE NOVEMBER 8, 2024

The Resiliency Committee last met on October 23<sup>rd</sup>. Planning for a learn and share workshop with other coastal communities continues. An update on the stormwater management project was provided by staff.

Word was received from DEMA that the new round of BRIC and FMA grants that was scheduled to open in December has been delayed or possibly cancelled as FEMA has run out of funds because of the hurricanes that occurred earlier this fall. This is a setback to the work of the committee as we were expecting to apply for implementation funds for the York Road flood mitigation project. We will seek other sources of funding for this project.

DEMA did inform us that our BRIC grant application for a Cat Hill flooding study—for which we have received "soft approval"—is still under review. Projects from this round of grants will be awarded funds, but when they will be available is yet to be determined.
