York Road Flood Mitigation Project

The next meeting of the Resiliency Committee will be **Tuesday**, **February 4** th **at 10 a.m**. The AECOM team will present their (final) recommended measures for flood mitigation on York Road. There will be time allotted for residents' comments to the Committee and questions for the project consultants. The link for remote attendance is posted on the meeting agenda on the Town website.

Offshore Wind Update

Last week, an Executive Order was issued by the President regarding offshore wind projects. The order temporarily halts the issuance of any new leases or federal permits for offshore wind projects. It is not clear at this time how previously approved projects, including the US Wind project off the coast of Ocean City, may be affected.

Prior to the Order, the Sussex County Council voted to deny US Wind a permit to construct a new electric substation on land adjoining the Indian River power plant in Dagsboro. The denial is being appealed in Delaware Superior Court. In addition, federal (BOEM) approval of the US Wind project is being challenged in federal court by the Town of Ocean City, Maryland, and other entities.

The Town continues to post, when available, new information and developments regarding offshore wind projects on its website under the "Offshore Wind" tab.
