TRASH

- Use appropriate trash containers to prevent loose debris from wind/birds/animals
- Secure trash containers during the off-season and during severe storms
- SOLIDIFY latex paint using kitty litter, sand or sawdust
- **DO NOT** place construction debris, auto batteries, flammable/hazardous materials, oil/petroleum products, oil based paint, rocks, bricks, concrete blocks, concrete, dirt, stumps, tires, & yard waste in trash pick up

YARD WASTE

- Must use recyclable paper bags only, no plastic bags
- Keep lid OFF when you using trash can for the yard waste
- Can take grass, leaves, pruning, brush, shrub, garden materials, Christmas trees
- Cut tree limbs up to 4 inches in diameter (no soil)
- Cut no longer than 4-ft. lengths and must be bundled, with cotton string only
- Logs are limited to 35 lbs. and 4 inches in diameter
- Place yard waste at curbside the night before pickup day
- **DO NOT** put trash in with yard waste

RECYCLE

- **RENTERS!** Please fill recycle container Thursday evening to ensure Friday pick up (this will provide empty bins for the next Renters)

BULK TRASH COLLECTION—Saturday, May 10th and September 13, 2025

- Remove freon from appliances and remove doors from freezers & refrigerators
- Remove gas & oil from lawnmowers. Tape a sign/label on item indicating removal
- SOLIDIFY latex paint with kitty litter, sand or sawdust (can also dispose in regular trash)
- Place items curbside the previous night (but no longer) to ensure collection
- **DO NOT PLACE** construction debris, automobile batteries, flammable/hazardous materials, oil/petroleum products, oil based paint, rocks, bricks, concrete blocks, concrete, dirt, stumps, tires, yard waste, propane tanks; and a/c units, freezers, refrigerators containing CFC freon gas.
- Inadvertent collection of material in/on/or adjacent to bulk items to be collected **WILL NOT** be the responsibility of Republic Services
