

JUNE 2026 COMMITTEE REPORTS

BICYCLE & PEDESTRIAN SAFETY (Shields)

- Committee met May 19 and discussed following topics:
 - Status of Grab a Flag Pilot Project which is awaiting approval from DELDOT. We are not buying kits until approval occurs. Discussed media and training efforts once approval is granted.
 - Planning for July 11 Bike Rodeo. ABC Ministries will participate. Roles assigned to volunteers.
 - Traffic issues discussed to include rolling stops at Canal/Tamarack/Russell intersections, potential to add red whirly-gig to problem stop signs, locations for planned speed indicator signs, communications between lifeguards and police when beach evacuations occur/repainting of street icons and lettering for pedestrian and cyclist safety/cyclist etiquette (“on your left”) and reflective gear at night for cyclists and pedestrians.
 - Potential attempt to enlist realtors in distributing safety info
- Next meeting scheduled for June 25.

RESILIENCY (Dondero)

The Committee last met on April 15 and will meet again on June 17.

The second phase of the York Road Flood Mitigation project is underway. The Chair and Town Manager held a kickoff meeting in May with members of the AECOM team. They will be conducting elevation surveys and performing other preliminary field work in the month of June.

The Chair and Town Manager also met in May with the consultants working on the Coastal Analysis and took them to various areas of Town to highlight flooding hot spots and view bulkhead elevations. Their data gathering and modeling process is underway.

The next order of business for the Committee will be discussing and recommending to the Council several changes to the Town Code.
