- York Road Phase 2 – AECOM completing elevation survey of roads along with identifying utilities, and drainage. Beginning solution analysis.
- Coastal Analysis (bulkhead study) – Verdantas communicating with AECOM to obtain pertinent elevation data.
- Two (2) residents of York Road have contacted the Town stating that there was ponding in front of their homes during the last heavy rain event. AECOM is evaluating.
